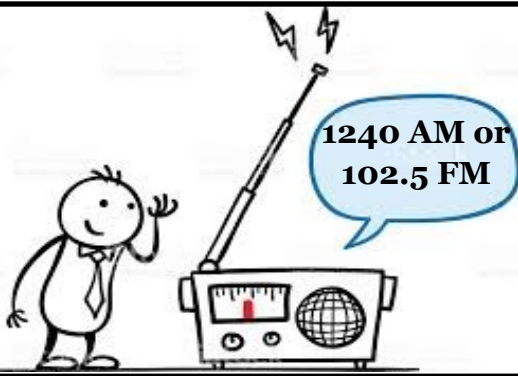

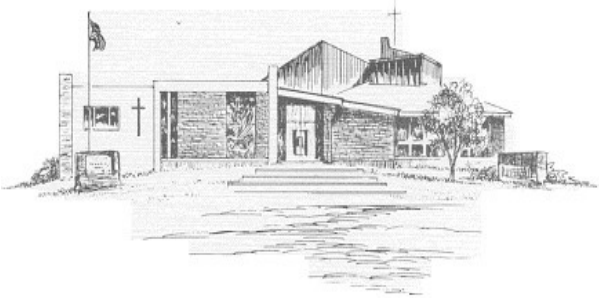

Church Council Meeting Summary

September 20, 2021

Council members attending: Doug Allie, Lacey Flaten, Greg Forrester, Shelly George, Chris Helland, Donna Lee, Lynn Lipszyc, Judi Martin, Jon Mattfeldt. Others attending: Leanne Fontaine, Pastor Scott Kiehn.

- The Living Lutheran magazine has been renewed.
- The August fifth Sunday noisy offering in August was \$203.03 which will be used for snacks at Irle School, Youth Dynamics, and FLC Preschool.
- A standing hand sanitizer dispenser was ordered for the south door of the church.
- The new financial secretary has been trained and Sunday money counters are organized.
- The biannual congregational meeting will be September 26. There will be a presentation on necessary church repairs and future property projects. New council members will be elected.
- With the absence of a church secretary, volunteers will be in the office. Jennifer Fewer will prepare bulletins, slides and preschool reports until a secretary is hired. The job opening has been announced on Sundays, included in the newsletter, posted in the Buzz, KLTZ, and Job Service.

Motions Passed

- Approved minutes and treasurer's report.
- The Wedding Guidelines for First Lutheran Church were approved for use.
- Funds were approved for furnace replacement and dining room sprinkler repairs.
- Recommend at the biannual meeting that the church hire an architect for an cost estimate and work needed to install a lift that makes all 4 levels of the church accessible for all, making four bathrooms handicap accessible, and fixing the roof and window above the altar.
- Approval to purchase a new laser color printer for the church office.
- The secretary/office manager job description was approved.
- Motion passes to have the church pianos tuned.

Reports

- Preschool--Shelly reported there are about 50 children enrolled, which is about the same as last year.
- Youth/Education--There were over 60 children at CSI.
- Discipleship--There will be a fifth Sunday noisy offering in October.
- Finance--Budget worksheets were given to each team.
- Stewardship--A Stewardship Drive with plans to fund future property projects is planned for October 24 - November 28. A letter will be mailed and talks at Sunday worship service are planned.
- Worship--The team will be preparing a congregational brunch on October 10. There may be 2 confirmations on October 31, Reformation Sunday.
- Executive--Approved hiring Peggy Hansen as financial secretary. Voted to give Bonnie Bell Chamber Bucks in appreciation for her time as church secretary.
